【Background】

Since its inauguration in 2011 at Harvard University, the U.S.-China Health Summit (the Summit) has been dedicated to advancing global health by promoting exchange of knowledge, ideas and experiences among current and future health sector leaders from China, the U.S. and other countries. The annual Summit has been held alternately in the U.S. and China which gathers together hundreds of leaders from academia, governmental and non-governmental organizations as well as industry to discuss important challenges and opportunities in health sector reforms and development. This “meeting of great minds” has helped inform the process of sound policy development, contributed to strengthening our mutual understanding, and fostered many collaborations in the health sector between the two countries and beyond.

2018 is unique for several reasons. First, it marks the 40-year anniversary of China’s inception of “*opening and economic reform policies*” and the 10th year of China’s “New Round of Healthcare Reforms.” Second, the *Alma-Ata Declaration* in 1978 emerged as a major milestone of the twentieth century in recognizing primary care as the key element and foundation as every citizen’s human right. Third, global trends in healthcare reform emphasized “universal healthcare coverage” and “value-based and people-centered integrated healthcare model” under the framework of the UN Sustainable Development Goals 2015-2030.

The 2018 U.S.-China Health Summit will be held in Chengdu, the beautiful capital city of Sichuan, China on October, 12-14, 2018. Themed Healthy China, Healthy Sichuan, the 8th U.S.-China Health Summit will gather together more than 800 leaders from the governments, academia, healthcare and biomedical industries for exchange of information and ideas, and for exploring collaborating opportunities, especially in Sichuan Province, which, with a population of 92 million, is keen on promoting healthy people and health industry as priority. The Summit will cover a wide range of themes such as “How to Shift from Volume to Value”, “How to Ensure Affordability, efficiency & Quality of Care”, “Novel Approaches to Healthcare Delivery & Payment Reform”, “How to “Prioritizing Mental Health & Elderly Care in China” etc.

We look forward to see you, our old friends and new participants, to come to Chengdu to meet with all the “great minds of the world” in healthcare in the coming October, 2018!

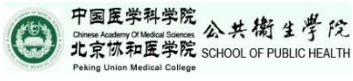
